Greenville College Choir to Present their Spring Tour Concert at New Life Church on March 19, 2010

La Plata, Maryland – The 46-voice Greenville College Choir will perform a concert at New Life Church, 9690 Shepherds Creek Place, La Plata, MD on Friday, March 19, 2010 at 8:00 pm. The Choir is taking a 10-day spring tour, performing in six states including stops in Chicago (IL), Toledo (OH), Gettysburg (PA), Princeton (NJ), Washington D.C. and Indianapolis (IN). This year's tour program, entitled "Kingdom Come," features diverse selections from South Africa, Germany, England, France, and America, composed over a period of 400 years.

Founded in 1927, the Greenville College Choir has attained a widespread reputation for performing sacred choral music of the highest quality. Recent appearances include a performance with the Boston Camerata and the Cathedral and Archdiocesan Choirs at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Louis in November, 2009. In 2008 the Greenville Choir performed at the American Choral Directors Association Central Division Convention in Grand Rapids, Michigan and went on a concert tour of Hungary, Romania, and Austria. Dr. Jeffrey Wilson, Director of Choral Studies at Greenville College, is the conductor of the Choir.

Greenville College is a four-year accredited Christian liberal arts school with more than 1,200 traditional undergraduate, graduate, and adult degree completion students. Founded in 1892 and affiliated with the Free Methodist Church, the college is located in Greenville, Illinois, 45 miles east of St. Louis, Missouri.
